You should only call an ambulance if you need one in an emergency, like the following: if someone has suddenly

collapsed, is unconscious, was involved in a car accident, has trouble breathing, has severe

pains, suffered severe burns etc. Please do not call an ambulance for the following reasons: to get taken to the hospital, to use instead of a taxi, because using an ambulance is free, for small injuries or ilnesses like cuts, scrapes, toothache etc.

By abusing the system you are putting the lives of others in danger. Thank you for your cooperation.

Includes measuring height and weight, a general and dental check-up, consultation about teeth, consultation about child care and so on. A notification will be sent to all children within the appropriate age range.

These health check-ups are free. Please ensure that you bring your Maternal Health Card (BOSHITECHO)

Vaccinate your child against Polio and Measles

予防接種

It is strongly recommended that you vaccinate your child against polio and measles. Your child should be vaccinated against polio once they are three months of age, but can be vaccinated up to the age of 7 and a half years. Vaccination against measles can start between 1 ~ 2 years of age, with regular boosters until the 3rd grade of senior high school. Almost all local clinics and hospitals in Iga offer these polio and measles vaccinations.

When arranging for your child to be vaccinated, call ahead to your preferred clinic or hospital to check the dates and times when vacinations are being administered. On the day, take your vaccination slip and mother-child health book (boshi techou). Read over the pamphlet you received from city hall in advance "Vaccinations and Children's Health" (Yobou sesshu to kodomo no kenkou). Do not get vaccinated if you are feeling ill or unwell.
