### Paperwork for Yellow-plate Vehicles and Mopeds

けいじどうしゃ げんどうきつき じてんしゃ など の てつづき

- ◆ Complete paperwork to take your vehicle off the road or change ownership early
- Complete necessary paperwork within the month of March

Annual yellow-plate vehicle tax is charged to the person who is registered as the owner of the vehicle as od April 1st. Due to this, even if you take your car off the road or transfer ownership to someone else after April 2nd, you will be the owner registered as responsible for paying the vehicle's tax for that fiscal year.

Many people therefore rush to complete paperwork to take their car off the road or change ownership at the end of March every year. If you need to complete such paperwork, make sure you do so early with plenty of time to have it processed before the new fiscal year starts. This is also the case for white-plate vehicles, so please leave plenty of time to complete this paperwork, too.

(What you need to complete the paperwork)

- oTaking a car off the road: Inkan (personal seal), number plate, number plate issuing certificate (hyoshiki koufu shomeisho)
- oChanging owndership: Inkan of both the previous and new owner, number plate issuing certificate
- XYou will need to take personal ID to complete all paperwork.

Oversized garbage can be picked up from your door step for a fee after making a reservation by telephone. Disposal of each items costs 200 yen, with a maximum of 5 items per collection. Reservations for collection will begin from April 1st.

#### Changes to the Long-term Care Insurance System かいご ほけん せいど が かわります

The following changes have been made to the Long-term Care Insurance System

- 1. From April 2015, the Long-term Care Insurance fee will change.
- 2. From April 2015, admission standards for Nursing Homes (special nursing homes for the elderly) will change.
- 3. From August 2015, the amount covered by the insurance party for those over the age of 65 with a certain income will increase from 10% to 20%.
- 4. From August 2015, the upper limit for individuals accessing high-cost care services in households where members are employed and have an average salary will change to 44,400 yen.
- 5. From August 2015, changes will be made to the applicability for reductions in cost of meals and residence fees for individuals with low incomes using nursing and residential facilities for short stays.
- 6. From August 2015, the payment limits for the composite calculation of major medical expenses & major nursing care expenses will change. **Enquiries: Kaigo Kourei Fukushi Ka TEL 0595-26-3939**

### Person Concerned Notification System ほんにん つうち せいど

Under this system, if a third party or proxy agent is issued a copy of your certificate of residence, family register etc, you can choose to be automatically notified by post of this action.

If you would like to use this system be notified, please register at the Residence Division (Jumin Ka) in City Hall, of the Residence and Welfare Division (Jumin Fukushi Ka) in any of city hall's branch offices. \*\*Registration is free \*\*Valid for three years from the day after registration.

XYou will be notified of the date of issue, type of document issued, number of copies issued and the type of person who requested said documents. You will not be notified of the address or the name of the person who requested your information. It is hoped that this system will prevent the leaking of personal information.

#### Number of scholarships & amount:

- \*The amount awarded is the amount you pay in tuition fees at the academic institution you are enrolled in.
- 1 Personal expenses for study exchange overseas: No more than 10. Upper limit of 1,200,000 yen per year (840,000 yen if there are official links between the academic institutions)
- 2 Foreign exchange students in Japan: No more than 10. Upper limit of 600,000 yen a year
- 3 Foreign students studying medicine or nursing: No more than 5. Upper limit of 600,000 yen a year **Application deadline:** 5pm on Friday 17th April.

## Information for Special Permanent Residence & Permanent Residence ざいりゅう かーどの きりかえ について



Due to changes in the law regarding registration of foreigners in Japan the Alien Registration System has been abolished and replaced with the Residence Permit system, whereby foreigners have a residence permit instead of an alien registration card. If you still have an alien registration card, you must switch this to a residence permit instead. Please make sure you do this by July 8,2015.

- 1 Special Permanent Residents should go to their local city hall to to make the switch to a Special Permanent Residence Certificate.
- 2 Permanent Residents should make the switch at their closest regional immigration bureau, branch immigration office or immigration counter located in other municipal buildings.

"Let's Protect Children from Crime"

As we transition from the Spring holidays to the new school year, the change in day to day rhythm of life can result in some children being exposed to crime.

To protect children from crime involving the internet and smartphones, do the following:

- oMake a promise not to look at or use dating websites, or meet people via such websites.
- Use content filtering services on mobiles phones.
- oBuild an relationship with your child where you can talk openly about mobile phone use.





#### Infant Health Checkups & Development Tests <あかちゃん の けんしん > Kenkou Suishin Ka TEL 0595-22-9653

☆In Iga, checkup examinations are available at 18 months (children up until 21 months can take it) and 3 years (for children up to 3 years and 9 months of age). Notifications will be sent out to homes with children eligibile for the checkups. These notifications will be in Japanese, so please bring your letter along with you to City Hall if you need help understanding its content.

#### 18 month Checkup (free)

This is a very important period in your child's development of basic functions such as speech, walking and so on, so the 18 month checkup is a general examination. Your child will be observed day by day to assess his or her emotional and physical development. Make use of this free checkup to make sure your child has a healthy upbringing.

[Examinations] Measuring weight, height, medical checkup, hearing test, reflexes, advice on dental health and nutrition.

[Bring] Mother-Child passbook (Boshi techo), forms

[Date] 10<sup>th</sup>Mar from 12:50 to 14:30 (Place: Haitopia Iga – in front of Uenoshi station) . 28<sup>th</sup>April from 12:50 to 14:30 (Place: Haitopia Iga ).



This is the time when a child is becoming aware of his or herself and beginning the important process of independence from their mother. A more detailed evaluation will be carried out, including checks of physical and psychological development, as well as teeth, hearing and vision. Aside from observing your child's development, the 3 year exam is also a chance for families with children to talk with and socialize with one another.

[Examinations] Urine exam, measuring weight and height, medical checkup, dental checkup, reflex development test, advice on dental health and nutrition.

[Bring] Mother-Child passbook (*Boshi techo*), forms, completed questionnaire on hearing and vision, urine sample

[Date] 12<sup>th</sup> Mar from 12:50 to 14:30 (Place: Haitopia Iga – in front of Uenoshi station). 16<sup>th</sup> April from 12:50 to 14:30 (Place: Haitopia Iga).

  - \* If you no longer need assistance, call the clinic or hospital to cancel your appointment.
- 3. The hospitals on duty are for patients with serious injuries or illnesses who need specialist medical care or who need to be admitted to hospital.
  - \* Only by referral from a medical facility, emergency consultant or taken by ambulance → Shimin Byouin
  - \* Not necessary to arrive by ambulance, but you must call ahead to say that you are on your way → Okanami and Nabari Hospitals

## Graduation and Matriculation Ceremonies

In Japan, graduation and matriculation
ceremonies take place in March and April.
These are formal, celebratory occasions and
there are certain rules of ettiquette when
attending as a parent or guardian. Be sure to
turn your phone off or put it on silent mode
before the ceremony begins. Also, do not
wear clothing that is too flashy. The most
important people in the ceremony are the
children, so the parents do not have to show
off.

For graduation ceremonies, black or navy is common, and for matriculations navy or grey are common. As much as possible it is a good idea to wear formal clothing.

Avoiding excessive jewelry is also recommended and wearing only necessary rings (e.g. wedding ring) is seen as the most fashionable.
