Prefectural Housing Applications Now Open けんえい じゅうたくの もうしこみ

Application Period: April 2015

Eligibility:

- 1 You must live or work in Mie Prefecture.
- **2** Be in difficulty with your living conditions.
- 3 Have family members who will be living with you, or plan to do so
 - Fiancees can apply, provided they register their marriage within 3 months of moving in
 Common-law couples can apply, provided they are not registered as married
- 4 Have a salary within the standard range designated by the Municipal Residence Law.

5 - Must have no outstanding bills in rent, car parking etc if you already live in prefectural housing.

6 – Not be behind in any tax payments 7 – You must have two guarantors

Note: Single mother families, families with elderly or disabled members are considered as priorities for housing. Please provide the necessary paperwork proving your current family situation if this applies to you.

If you have applied for prefectural housing in the past but been rejected 3 times, you can apply for preferential treatment. Please read the booklet outlining the rules for prefectural housing. You can receive an application form and rules booklet from the prefectural building in Ueno (ken chousha) or in City Hall's Shimin Seikatu Ka.

Financial Support System for School-goers しゅうがくえんじょ せいど

Iga City can provide some financial support to those who have difficulties with school-related costs such as school meal fees, school materials etc. If you wish to access this support, you must apply for it. The support is only offered on an annual basis, so you have to apply for it every year. If you receive the support this year, you do not automatically receive it again next year.

* Support will not be available where it coincides with support available under welfare support. Eligibility: Guardians of students enrolled in a municipal elementary or junior high school. *Income thresholds apply.

Apply to: the school your child is enrolled in.

About The National Pension Scheme こくみんねんきん の はなし

1. The method of enrollment in the National Pension scheme differs depending on the person. In Japan, all those living in Japan between the ages of 20 and 60 are enrolled in the national pension scheme. Enrollment type is divided into three categories depending on your employment status etc, and the necessary procedures for enrollment vary accordingly.

•Category 1 Enrollment

For the self-employed, students, part-time workers and unemployed, enrollment procedures should be done at your nearest city hall.

Category 2 Enrollment

Company employees who are enrolled in welfare annuity insurance or cooperative societies should carry out the enrollment procedures at their place of employment.

•Category 3 Enrollment

Spouses of those in category 2 should carry out the procedures via their spouse's place of employment.

2. Did you know? National Pension Scheme Payments Exemption System

If you forgot to make your payment and an unexpected accident occurs resulting in disability or death, in some instances it may not be possible to receive the Basic Disability Pension or Basic Bereavement

Pension. There is a system whereby you can be made exempt from making payments if it is difficult to make payments due to financial difficulties.

XAs a rule, applications must be made on an annual basis. Furthermore, applications can be made retroactively for up to 2 years and 1 month. Please ask for more details.

Get your dog vaccinated. Dog owners are bound by law to have their dog vaccinated every year between April 1st and June 30th. This vaccination is available at any vets in Iga, or at certain venues run by the city with the cooperation of

the Mie Vets Association. If your dog is already registered and only needs a rabies shot – 3200 yen

Registering your dog at the same as getting a rabies shot - 6200 yen (3200 fee for the shot and 3000 fee for dog registration).

Infant Health Checkups & Development Tests <あかちゃんのけんしん > Kenkou Suishin Ka TEL 0595-22-9653

☆In Iga, checkup examinations are available at 18 months (children up until 21 months can take it) and 3 years (for children up to 3 years and 9 months of age). Notifications will be sent out to homes with children eligibile for the checkups. These notifications will be in Japanese, so please bring your letter along with you to City Hall if you need help understanding its content.

18 month Checkup (free)

This is a very important period in your child's development of basic functions such as speech, walking and so on, so the 18 month checkup is a general examination. Your child will be observed day by day to assess his or her emotional and physical development. Make use of this free checkup to make sure your child has a healthy upbringing.

[Examinations] Measuring weight, height, medical checkup, hearing test, reflexes, advice on dental health and nutrition.

[Bring] Mother-Child passbook (Boshi techo), forms

[Date] 28thApril from 12:50 to 14:30 (Place: Haitopia Iga).19thMay from 12:50 to 14:30 (Place: Haitopia Iga – in front of Uenoshi station).



3 years (free)

This is the time when a child is becoming aware of his or herself and beginning the important process of independence from their mother. A more detailed evaluation will be carried out, including checks of physical and psychological development, as well as teeth, hearing and vision. Aside from observing your child's development, the 3 year exam is also a chance for families with children to talk with and socialize with one another.

[Examinations] Urine exam, measuring weight and height, medical checkup, dental checkup, reflex development test, advice on dental health and nutrition.

[Bring] Mother-Child passbook (*Boshi techo*), forms, completed questionnaire on hearing and vision, urine sample

[Date] 16thApril from 12:50 to 14:30 (Place: Haitopia Iga). 12th, 28th May from 12:50 to 14:30 (Place: Haitopia Iga – in front of Uenoshi station).



◎ If possible, see your regular doctor during normal clinic opening hours.

◎Choose a regular clinic to go to when you need to see a doctor.

©What should you do if you fall sick suddenly , or are sick on a day when the clinic you go to is closed?

* After that, call the clinic/hospital to confirm opening hours and so on.

- * When you go there, be sure to take your health insurance card/certificate.
- * If you no longer need assistance, call the clinic or hospital to cancel your appointment.
- 3. The hospitals on duty are for patients with serious injuries or illnesses who need specialist medical care or who need to be admitted to hospital.
 - * Only by referral from a medical facility, emergency consultant or taken by ambulance → Shimin Byouin
 - * Not necessary to arrive by ambulance, but you must call ahead to say that you are on your way \rightarrow Okanami and Nabari Hospitals

Financial Support for Taxi etc Services for the Severely Disabled

じゅうどしょうがいしゃ タクシー ねんりょうひのじょせい

Financial support is available for the transport costs of the severely disabled in order to ensure that they can fully contribute to society and also have easy access to hospital. This is available for either taxi fares, gasoline costs or for moped usage costs.

Eilgibility: Anyone with one of the following certificates: *shintai* shougaisha techou 1kyuu, 2kyuu; ryouiku techou A1, A2; seishinshougaisha hoken fukushi techou 1kyuu

How to apply: Bring your disability certificate, personal seal, driver's licence and car registration (*shaken*) (in the case of a moped) and apply at the Disability Welfare Dept. or Citizen's Welfare Dept in any of the city hall branch offices.

Helicobacter Pylori Bacteria Screening and Removal – Protection against Stomach Cancer

ひろりきんの けんさと じょきん

Helicobacter Pylori is a bacteria which lives in human stomachs that is believed to be closely connected to stomach ulcers, duodenal ulcers and stomach cancer. By undergoing screening to check if you have Helicobacter Pylori in your stomach, and by taking the appropriate medication to eradicate it if you do, you are helping to promote the prevention of stomach cancer. Screening is available for residents of Iga between the ages of 20 and 69 (born between 1 April 1945 – 31 March 1996)

Screening: Free

•Bacteria Removal: 2,400 yen (please pay this amount at the clinic you go to for the screening)

% If you wish to have a further screening after removal, you will have to bear the full cost for this by yourself.

% Screening and removal are available to each person only once. The success rate of bacteria removal is 90%.

Screening Method: Stool Antigen Test (Stool Examination)
How to register:

•Screening : Complete the Helicobacter Pylori Screening Registration Form and submit to the next clinic that is offering the bacteria screening.

•Bacteria Removal: Complete the Helicobacter Pylori Bacteria Removal Form and Health Questionnaire, and submit to the next clinic that is offering the bacteria screening.

% The above forms can be found at the clinics offering the screening and removal procedures.

When registering, please bring your health insurance card.
