Iga Sasayuri Scholarship Fund

- Be a member of a household with a combined annual income of less than 7,800,000 yen.

Iga City Scholarship Fund

Scholarships are available to highschool and university students in Iga in order to ensure that all have equal access to education, and to foster the growth of young people who can make positive contributions to society.

- (1) Both the student and their guardian are residents in Iga, except for those who changed their address in order to commute to their school or university.
- ②Be currently enrolled in either a senior high school, vocational school or university etc.
- 3No members of the same household as the applicant should be required to pay residence tax based on income.

Cancer screenings and medical checkups are offered twice a year. This is the first round of screenings available for the fiscal year 2015. Please check the dates and times of the screening or checkup which you would like before making an appointment. These are only available to those who meet the requirements below and are residents in Iga. It is not possible to take the same screening twice in the same fiscal year. Also, if you have any symptoms which concern you, please go and see your medical practitioner directly.

Tax notices for municipal and prefectural tax will be posed on Friday 12th of June. You can easily make your payments at any bank or convenience store. Payment Deadline Regular tax payments are done 4 times annually. The payment deadline for these payments are the end of June, August, October and January. *If the last day of these months should fall on a weekend or public holiday, the payment deadline will be the following day.

Temporary Welfare Benefits and Childrearing Households Temporary Special Benefits

りんじふくしきゅうふきん こそだてせたいりんじとくれいきゅうふきん

The Childrearing Households Temporary Special Benefit is available for those who are not in arrears in their residence tax payments, and who have to date received 6 months worth of child allowance. Eligible children receive 3000 yen each (except for households already receiving special benefits)this year.

Applications will be enclosed with the child allowance current circumstances update form sent at the beginning of June. Please use the application form if you are eligible. The benefit will be transferred to your bank account after October.

The Temporary Welfare Benefit is not available to those who are not up to date in their residence tax payments (dependents and welfare recipients are not eligible). 6000 yen per person. Applications are expected to beging in August. Please refer to the July issue of this newsletter for futher details.

Infant Health Checkups & Development Tests <あかちゃん の けんしん > Kenkou Suishin Ka TEL 0595-22-9653

☆In Iga, checkup examinations are available at 18 months (children up until 21 months can take it) and 3 years (for children up to 3 years and 9 months of age). Notifications will be sent out to homes with children eligibile for the checkups. These notifications will be in Japanese, so please bring your letter along with you to City Hall if you need help understanding its content.

18 month Checkup (free)

This is a very important period in your child's development of basic functions such as speech, walking and so on, so the 18 month checkup is a general examination. Your child will be observed day by day to assess his or her emotional and physical development. Make use of this free checkup to make sure your child has a healthy upbringing.

[Examinations] Measuring weight, height, medical checkup, hearing test, reflexes, advice on dental health and nutrition.

[Bring] Mother-Child passbook (Boshi techo), forms

[Date] 9th30thJune from 12:50 to 14:30 (Place: Haitopia Iga). 25thJune from 13:00 to 13:30 (Place: Aoyama hoken center).14thJuly from 12:50 to 14:30 (Place: Haitopia Iga – in front of Uenoshi station).

3 years (free)

This is the time when a child is becoming aware of his or herself and beginning the important process of independence from their mother. A more detailed evaluation will be carried out, including checks of physical and psychological development, as well as teeth, hearing and vision. Aside from observing your child's development, the 3 year exam is also a chance for families with children to talk with and socialize with one another.

[Examinations] Urine exam, measuring weight and height, medical checkup, dental checkup, reflex development test, advice on dental health and nutrition.

[Bring] Mother-Child passbook (Boshi techo), forms, completed questionnaire on hearing and vision, urine sample

 - * After that, call the clinic/hospital to confirm opening hours and so on.
 - * When you go there, be sure to take your health insurance card/certificate.
 - * If you no longer need assistance, call the clinic or hospital to cancel your appointment.
- 3. The hospitals on duty are for patients with serious injuries or illnesses who need specialist medical care or who need to be admitted to hospital.
 - * Only by referral from a medical facility, emergency consultant or taken by ambulance → Shimin Byouin
 - * Not necessary to arrive by ambulance, but you must call ahead to say that you are on your way → Okanami and Nabari Hospitals


