

Prefectural Housing [Iga Block] Hattori ,Casa Ueno and Kuramochi

Eligibility:

- 1 You must live or work in Mie Prefecture.
- 2 Be in difficulty with your living conditions.
- 3 Have family members who will be living with you, or plan to do so
 - Fiancees can apply, provided they register their marriage within 3 months of moving in - Common-law couples can apply, provided they are not registered as married
- 4 Have a salary within the standard range designated by the Municipal Residence Law.
- 5 Must have no outstanding bills in rent, car parking etc if you already live in prefectural housing.
- 6 Not be behind in any tax payments, 7 You must have two guarantors

Expansion of Welfare Medical Fees Aid to Junior High School Students who are currently Hospital Outpatients ふくしいりょうひの ちゅうがくせい つういんぶんの かくだい

《Hospital Visits from September 1 Onward》 Financial aid for junior high school students who are currently hospital inpatients or outpatients (who have received a certificate of eligibility). Up until now, financial aid has only been available to help pay the medical fees of junior high school students who are currently in hospital, pending application and subsequent approval for the aid. From September 1st, the financial aid will be available, upon application and subsequent approval, for junior high school students who are both in hospital and visiting as outpatients. An application form was sent to those who are eligible to apply at the end of June, so if you received one, please complete and return it within the designated time.

[How to Apply] Submit the application form along with any other Please fill in and sign the application form. necessary documents and return in the enclosed envelope.

[Documentation required to apply] Copy of health insurance ID (should include the name of the child who will receive the aid) Proof of tax payment for fiscal year 2015 (ie 2014 tax payment) of the guardians/parents (must include income, deductions, your current tax payment status etc).

However, if both guardians/parents are registered as living at an address in Iga city as of January 1st 2015, this is not necessary.

Regarding the introduction of My Number System (Social Security and Tax Number System) まいなんばー せいどについて

From October 2015, all the citizens will be notified with a 12- digit number (individual).

* My Number System will be usedfrom January 2016, in administrative procedures regarding social welfare and its benefits, as well as in public taxes and countermeasures on the case of a natural disaster.

* This individual number will be used only for administrative procedures purposes determined by government, there is no risk of this number goes to thirdparties.

* The individual number will serve you for your lifetime, so ti is important to take proper steps to protect it.

> Cyclists who violate traffic law repeatedly will be required to attend a training じてんしゃの こうつう いはんについて

As of June 1st, 2015 the "Training System for Cyclists" come into effect. The cyclists who commit repeated traffic violation will be required to attend a 3- hour training. The training will cost the participants ¥5.700. In the case a cyclist does not attend the training after receiving the order, a fine of up to ¥50.000will be applied. This new system has been created in order to make the cyclists aware the traffic law for bicycles are not different from those for vehicles

Expansion of Free Child Care to Third Child and Younger だい3 しいこうの ほいくりょう むりょうか

Preschool 《Current System》

Public : Fees are waived for infants with two or more siblings below grade 3 of elementary school as of the first day of the fiscal Private : Financial aid for entering preschool is available for infants who have 3 or more siblings that are in 3rd grade vear elementary school or above living in the same household on the date the eligibility for subsidies is determined.

《Changes from September》

Public : Fees will be waived from September on for infants with two or more siblings below the age of 18 as of the first day of Private : Financial aid for entering preschool will be available from the start of fiscal year 2015 for infants who the fiscal vear. have 2 or more siblings that are under the age of 18 on the first day of the fiscal year.

Creche (Day Care) 《Current System》

Creche fees are waived for the third child and below when there are other children in the same household also enrolled in a preschool or creche. 30% of creche fees are waived for infants who have 2 or more siblings below the age of 18 as of the first day of the fiscal year.

《Changes from September》

Your National Health Insurance Tax こくみん けんこう ほけんぜい に ついて

In Japan, everyone is enrolled in health insurance in one form or another. This applies to those with national health insurance, health insurance for the elderly, their workplace's insurance scheme and even those on income support. The premiums you pay for your insurance plan and funding from the government etc used to pay for medical fees incurred. This helps support your health when you pay for all your medical fees, postnatal childcare stipends, health check-ups and so on.

Even if the head of the household is not enrolled in national health insurance, the tax payment slip will still be addressed to the household head if another member of the household is enrolled in the national health insurance program.

Regular tax payments will be split into 9 installments starting from July, running through to March 2016.

Special tax payments (taken from your pension etc), will be split into three installments in October, December and February. Reduction in Tax payments required for the Involuntarily Unemployed

If you have left your job because your employer has gone bankrupt or you have been fired, then you are eligible to pay reduced tax fees. Please bring your certificate of proof of receipt of employment insurance and your personal seal in order to apply for this reduced rate of tax payment.

[Period of Eligibility] The month of the day after becoming unemployed until the end of the fiscal year.

Do you know what nursing care insurance is? かいご ほけん せいど

Thinking about the future of you and your family ~ How does nursing care insurance work?

Everyone above the age of 40 has to pay an insurance fee, which is then later used to pay for nursing care services. In order to access these services, you must be deemed as in need of them. In order to be recognized as in need of these services, you can apply at City Hall's Kaigo Korei Fukushi Ka, or at any of the City Hall Branch offices.

The nursing care insurance system is in place so that everyone can continue living a healthy life in their local area for as long as possible, and so that even when such nursing care becomes necessary, you can still lead an independent and dignified life. The nursing care services are funded through a combination of insurances costs paid by those over the age of 40, as well as public funding from national, prefectural and municipal taxes. Those between the ages of 40 and 64 pay this nursing care insurance fee as part of their regular insurance fees, and those over the age of 65 can either have it subtracted directly from their pension, or can choose to pay directly at city hall.

Infant Health Checkups & Development Tests <あかちゃんのけんしん > Kenkou Suishin Ka TEL 0595-22-9653

In Iga, checkup examinations are available at 18 months (children up until 21 months can take it) and 3 years (for children up to 3 years and 9 months of age). Notifications will be sent out to homes with children eligibile for the checkups. These notifications will be in Japanese, so please bring your letter along with you to City Hall if you need help understanding its content.

18 month Checkup (free)

This is a very important period in your child's development of basic functions such as speech, walking and so on, so the 18 month checkup is a general examination. Your child will be observed day by day to assess his or her emotional and physical development. Make use of this free checkup to make sure your child has a healthy upbringing.

[Examinations]Measuring weight, height, medical checkup, hearing test, reflexes, advice on dental health and nutrition.

3 years (free)

This is the time when a child is becoming aware of his or herself and beginning the important process of independence from their mother. A more detailed evaluation will be carried out, including checks of physical and psychological development, as well as teeth, hearing and vision. Aside from observing your child's development, the 3 year exam is also a chance for families with children to talk with and socialize with one another.

[Examinations] Urine exam, measuring weight and height, medical checkup, dental checkup, reflex development test, advice on dental health and nutrition.

[Bring] Mother-Child passbook (*Boshi techo*), forms, completed questionnaire on hearing and vision, urine sample

[Date] 30th July from 12:50 to 14:30 (Place: Haitopia Iga – in front of Uenoshi station). 20thAugust from 12:50 to 14:30 (Place: Haitopia Iga).

* After that, call the clinic/hospital to confirm opening hours and so on.

* When you go there, be sure to take your health insurance card/certificate.

* If you no longer need assistance, call the clinic or hospital to cancel your appointment.

- 3 .The hospitals on duty are for patients with serious injuries or illnesses who need specialist medical care or who need to be admitted to hospital.
 - * Only by referral from a medical facility, emergency consultant or taken by ambulance Shimin Byouin
 - * Not necessary to arrive by ambulance, but you must call ahead to say that you are on your way Okanami and Nabari Hospitals
