The expiry date on current insurance certificates is September 30th. The new certificate which you can use from October 1st will be posted to you after September 13th. Please use your new card after this time.

When it has arrived, make sure that all the details such as address, name etc. are displayed correctly. If there is a mistake or if your new card does not arrive, contact the Hoken Nenkin Division or Jumin Fukushi Division in any of city hall's branch offices. Please also check the expiry date. Cards usually have a limit of one year, but this may differ in the following cases: For people turning 75, until the day before their 75th birthday. 3. The hospitals on duty are for patients with serious injuries or illnesses who need specialist medical care or who need to be admitted to hospital.

* Only by referral from a medical facility, emergency consultant or taken by ambulance \rightarrow Shimin Byouin

* Not necessary to arrive by ambulance, but you must call ahead to say that you are on your way \rightarrow Okanami and Nabari Hospitals
