Tax Declarations ぜいきん の しんこく

By submitting your tax return, you may be eligible for a reimubrsement of some of the money you paid in tax.

[Time] 16th February to 15th March, 09:00 ~ 17:00 * Closed on weekends

[Venue] Yume Dome Ueno, 2nd Gymnasium

- ♦ Who needs to submit a tax declaration?
 - ① Anyone that receives a salary but did not complete their year-end tax adjustment
 - 2 Anyone who has received a salary from more than one company/employer during the year
 - 3 Anyone who left their place of work and started a new job in the same year
 - (4) Anyone who did not include information about their dependents in their year-end tax adjustment
- ♦What do you need to make a tax declaration?
- My number card / My number notification card
- A copy of your residence card
- The original copy of your certificate of income and withholding tax
- A copy of the bank book (*tsuchou*) for the bank account you would like your tax reimbursement to be sent to (the page which shows your name and account number).
- Passport
- Personal seal (inkan)
- Documentation (including Japanese translation) to prove your dependents
- Documentation (including Japanese translation) to prove that you are sending money to dependents overseas.
- · Your national health insurance certificate
- · National pension certificate
- Proof of life insurance fee exemption
- Proof of medical costs for you and your family members, etc

You cannot make your tax declarations at the Ueno Tax Office, Iga Prefectural Tax Office or Iga City Hall.

Municipal certifications and documents are issued upon presentation of your tax return slip.

If those who are required to pay income tax, municipal and prefectural tax do not file their tax returns, they cannot be issued the relevant documents (proof of income, proof of taxes paid) that are needed in order to apply for changes in residency status, child benefit, educational support, public housing etc. They may not be able to access other public services, either

⑤Plan to live with family members (including boyfriend, girlfriend).

⑥Have an income within the required bracket to live in public housing. ⑦Have two guaruntors.

Door to Door Oversized Garbage Collection Service そだいごみ こべつ しゅうしゅう じぎょう

Oversized garbage, such as furniture and bed items, bycicles, fan heaters and large electrical appliances, can be picked up from your door step for a fee after making a reservation by telephone. Disposal of each items costs 200 yen, with a maximum of 5 items per collection.

*According to The Home Appliance Recycling Act, this collection excludes the four types of home appliances: televisions, refrigerators/freezers, air conditioners and clothes washers/dryers.

<u>How to apply:</u> Make a reservation call to the Oversized Garbage Collection Center and buy the Oversized Garbage Disposal Ticket at supermarkets, shops, or JA shops. Stick the ticket on the garbage and put it out in the promised place before 9:00am (8:30am in Aoyama) of the promised day.

In Iga, checkup examinations are available at 18 months (children up until 21 months can take it) and 3 years (for children up to 3 years and 9 months of age). Notifications will be sent out to homes with children eligibile for the checkups. These notifications will be in Japanese, so please bring your letter along with you to City Hall if you need help understanding its content.

Dogs and cats live for more than 10 years. Think about whether you can keep them with responsibility to the end.

-Don't let the animal cause harm or trouble to humans.

The unconfined dogs are prohibited. Don't let be a nuisance over animal excrement or barking to neighbors.

-Don't breed the animal unnecessarily.

If you don't want breeding, take contraception and castration surgery.

-Acquire correct information about infectious diseases of the animal.

-Define the owner of the animal.
