Nursery School Enrollment ほいくしょ(えん) にゅうしょしゃ ぼしゅう

If you want to enroll your child in Nursery school from next year, be register as follows.

Who is eligible? All children living in Iga between the ages of 0 (no younger than 56s days old) and 5 who fulfill the Nursery school entry requirements. Please contact us for further details on these entry requirements. Even if you wish to enroll your child after the start of the year (after May), you must still register at this time.

Registration Period: 15th – 31st October, 08:30 – 17:00 (weekdays only)

Enrollment forms will be available from October 9th at HoikuYouchien Ka in City Hall, any of the City Hall branch offices or any of the Nursery schools in Iga.

<p>Availability: 15th October - 31st January, 2019</p> <p>Eligibility: Registered as living in Iga and not yet school age (Born after April 2nd 2012)</p> <p>Amount: Up to 1500 yen per vaccination (*max. of two vaccinations)</p> <p>Please bring: health insurance card, mother-child passbook (Boshi techo).</p> <p><u>In Iga:</u> Make an appointment directly with the clinic. The amount you pay will already have the amount of financial support included in it. You do not have to file for reimbursement.</p> <p><u>Outside Iga:</u> Make an appointment directly with the clinic. Please pay the full amount. The financial support will not have been deducted. Please bring a receipt which shows where you got the vaccination and how much it cost, your inkan and your bank book (so the money can be transferred to your account). You can find the form to apply for reimbursement at the Health Dept. in City Hall, or download it from the city's website.</p>	<p>Availability: 15th October - 31st January, 2019.</p> <p>Locations: Any medical clinic in Mie Prefecture</p> <p>Eligibility:</p> <p>① Registered as living in Iga and over 65 on the day of vaccination.</p> <p>② Between 60 and 65 on the day of vaccination with immune system deficiencies and in possession of a Grade 1 disability passbook.</p> <p>Amount you pay: You pay 2000 yen (directly to the clinic). Free for those receiving welfare support.</p> <p><u>In Iga:</u> Make an appointment directly with the clinic.</p> <p><u>Outside Iga:</u> Please contact the Health Dept. in Iga if you want to get the vaccination outside Iga. Please take your health insurance certificate and health passbook with you. If you do not have a health passbook, you will be given a certificate to show that you have been vaccinated.</p>

Application period: from October 1st to 31st.

Prefectural Housing: [Iga Block] Hattori 2(for Single and Regular Occupant), Casa Ueno 1(for Regular Occupant)

Eligibility:

- 1 – Reside or work in Mie.
- 2 – Be in difficulty with your living conditions.
- 3 – Have family members who will be living with you, or plan to do so
 - Fiancees can apply, provided they register their marriage within 3 months of moving in
 - Common-law couples can apply, provided they are not registered as married
- 4 – Have a salary within the standard range designated by the Municipal Residence Law.
- 5 – Must have no outstanding bills in rent, car parking etc if you already live in prefectural housing.
- 6 – Not be behind in any tax payments
- 7 – You must have two guarantors

Application forms can be found in any municipal office. Ask for “ken’ei juutaku no moushikomi sho”

Infant Health Checkups & Development Tests <あかちゃん の けんしん > Kenkou Suishin Ka TEL 0595-22-9653

In Iga, checkup examinations are available at 18 months (children up until 21 months can take it) and 3 years (for children up to 3 years and 9 months of age). Notifications will be sent out to homes with children eligible for the checkups. These notifications will be in Japanese, so please bring your letter along with you to City Hall if you need help understanding its content.

18 month Checkup (free)

【Examinations】 Measuring weight, height, medical checkup, hearing test, reflexes, advice on dental health and nutrition.

【Bring】 Mother-Child passbook (*Boshi techo*), forms

【Date and Place】

18th October, 6th November from 13:00 to 14:30
(Place: Haitopia Iga)



3 Years Checkup (free)

【Examinations】 Urine exam, measuring weight and height, medical checkup, dental checkup, reflex development test, advice on dental health and nutrition.

【Bring】 Mother-Child passbook (*Boshi techo*), forms, completed questionnaire on hearing and vision, urine sample

* After that, call the clinic/hospital to confirm opening hours and so on.

* When you go there, be sure to take your health insurance card/certificate.

* If you no longer need assistance, call the clinic or hospital to cancel your appointment.



3. The hospitals on duty are for patients with serious injuries or illnesses who need specialist medical care or who need to be admitted to hospital.

* Only by referral from a medical facility, emergency consultant or taken by ambulance → Shimin Byouin

* Not necessary to arrive by ambulance, but you must call ahead to say that you are on your way → Okanami and Nabari Hospitals

Lights on Before Dark Initiative

【Active Period】 October 1st – December 31st

【Details】 - Turning on headlights and lamps early when the sun begins to set. (cars, motorbikes and bicycles)

- When going out at sunset or night, wear bright clothing and light reflecting belts. (pedestrians and cyclists) Sunset in autumn and winter coincides with rush hour, bringing with it a greater chance of traffic accidents. To prevent this, we have launched the 'Lights on Before Dark Initiative'

Disaster Prevention for Your Children's Safety

ぼうさいねっと こどものためにできること

To live with no need to worry for an emergency, even you have small children in your family, add a little consideration into general disaster prevention measures.

- Check and secure a safe space for children, for example around the baby bed or the playroom.
- Check the absolute necessities; □ Dried milk and the bottle (The milk packaged in subdivision and the disposable bottles would be more convenient.) □ Cooking water □ The retort-packed baby food □ Snacks □ Cloths (long-sleeved, long pants even in summer) □ Disposable diapers □ Big wipe □ Plastic bags for garbage □ Toys □ Story books □ Towels □ Medicines and prescriptions □ Copy of *Boshi-techo* (the maternity record book) and *Hoken-sho* (the insurance certificate)
- Carry your baby piggyback or in a sling because it's dangerous to use buggy when you evacuate.

Minimum wage: ¥846/hour(¥26 increase compared to 2017)

Effective date: October 1st, 2018

※This minimum wage applies to everyone working in Mie Prefecture (Excluding those working in an industry with a designated minimum wage).
