Request for Coronavirus Prevention Measures during Seasonal Events

きせっ、ぎょうじ 季節の行事などにおける新型コロナウィルス感染防止対策<三重県からのお願い>

During the holidays at the end and beginning of the year, many events will be held where there will be many people. Mie province calls on everyone to observe the measures to prevent the spread of coronavirus.

- 1. Wear masks, wash your hands well, keep an appropriate distance from other people, avoid places with a lot of people and observe the basic measures to prevent the new coronavirus.
- Avoid participating in events that have not taken basic measures to prevent the coronavirus. Mainly, parties and events where an undetermined number of people will be very close and will have many close conversations.
- If you are going to attend events, wear masks, wash your hands well, keep an appropriate distance 3.
- from other people, avoid loud conversations and take appropriate preventive measures.
- Avoid spending too much time with many people on the streets, restaurants and other places, and also refrain from drinking alcohol at night and at seasonal events.
- Spend more time indoors with your family. There are several new ways to entertain yourself as you participate in online events.
- Use coronavirus prevention applications.

税金の由告 **Tax Declarations**

By submitting your tax return, you may be eligible for a reimbursement of some of the money you paid in tax. (Time) February 16 - March 15, 9am - 5pm *Reception will close at 4pm *Closed on weekends and public holiday [Venue] Yume Dome Ueno, 2nd Gymnasium **<u>**An entrance ticked is required this year.</u>**

*You can get the ticket on the day at the door but may be asked to come at a later date. Also you can get the ticket on the LINE App. Check the website of National Tax Agency (Kokuzei-cho) for more details.

*When you come to the venue, please wear a mask, sanitize your hands, avoid crowds and measure your temperature at the gate. If you have a higher temperature than 37.5°C, you will be refused admission. Thank you for your cooperation.

- Who needs to submit a tax declaration?
 - ① Anyone that receives a salary but did not complete their year-end tax adjustment
 - Anyone who has received a salary from more than one company/employer during the year
 - Anyone who left their place of work and started a new job in the same year
- Anyone who did not include information about their dependents in their year-end tax adjustment, etc.
- ◆What do you need to make a tax declaration?
- My number card / My number notification card A copy of your residence card The original copy of your certificate of income and withholding tax • A copy of the bank book (tsuchou) for the bank account you would like your tax reimbursement to be sent to (the page which shows your name and account number). Passport
- · Documentation (including Japanese translation) to prove your dependents • Personal seal (inkan)
- Documentation (including Japanese translation) to prove that you are sending money to dependents overseas.
- · Your national health insurance certificate
- National pension certificate Proof of life insurance fee exemption

• Proof of medical costs for you and your family members, etc

You cannot make your tax declarations at the Ueno Tax Office, Iga Prefectural Tax Office or Iga City Hall. @Municipal certifications and documents are issued upon presentation of your tax return slip.

If those who are required to pay income tax, municipal and prefectural tax do not file their tax returns, they cannot be issued the relevant documents (proof of income, proof of taxes paid) that are needed in order to apply for changes in residency status, child benefit, educational support, public housing etc. They may not be able to access other public services, either.

*A big support in the future

The national pension is a system that people from 20 years old to 60 years old join and pay insurance premiums. This is stable because the nation operates with responsibility and pension benefits are guaranteed throughout the lifetime.

*Not only for the old age

In addition to "the old age pension" for the elders, there are "the disabled pension" for the disabled person who had aftereffects of sickness or accidents and "the surviving family pension" for the surviving family who's lost the main earner.

*A period of grace

There is a system in place to have a period of grace of the pension payment for the following.

- -Some designated college students who have income below a certain amount
- -Those who are not students, who are under 50 years old and whose total

income with the spouse is less than a certain amount.



[Eligibility] To apply for this housing, you must meet the following requirements:

- ①Reside or work in Mie.
- ②Be in need of housing.
- 3Are up to date in your tax payments.
- (4) If you have been living in public housing, you do not have any outstanding bills or payments (rent, parking fee etc).
- ⑤Plan to live with family members (including boyfriend, girlfriend).
- 6 Have an income within the required bracket to live in public housing.
- ⑦Have two guaruntors.

Emergency Call 110 緊急通報 110 番

Call 110 is a dedicated "the emergency call" only for when an incident or accident occurs and you want police officers to come as soon as possible. When you make a call 110, please calm yourself down and report the following;

- WHAT ...What happened?
- WHERE ...Where it happened?
- WHEN ...When it happened?
- WHO ...Are there any Criminals or Opponents?
- Your name, address and telephone number

Do not call while driving a bicycle or car as it is very dangerous. Stop at a safe place and call 110.

Medical Expenses under National Health Insurance 医療費のお知

We will send a "Notice of National Health Insurance Medical Expenses (国民健康保険医療費のお知らせ)" to those who have received medical treatment under the National Health Insurance. Please do not lose this notice as it can be used as a "statement of medical expense deduction" for the procedure of medical expense deduction and as it cannot be reissued.

If you have medical expenses not listed in this notice, you will need to prepare a "statement of medical expense deduction" based on the receipt issued by the medical institution and attach the statement to medical expense deduction. Keep the receipt for 5 years from the final tax return deadline. Also, if you are covered by "a Large Amount of Medical Expenses", please deduct that amount from your own expense.
