Nursery School Enrollment from April 2025 来春4月からの入園児募集

If you want to enroll your child in Hoikusho or Hoikuen(day nursery) or Nintei Kodomoen(Center for Childcare and Educations) from next year, register as follows.

[Admission Eligibility] Children between the ages of 0 and 5 years old who live in Iga city and require daycare due to their parents' employment or other reasons.

[Where you can get the application form] Each Hoikusho, Hoikuen, and Nintei Kodomoen as well as at Hoiku Yochien-ka in city hall and each branch offices

8:30 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. (except Saturdays, Sundays and national holidays)

How to dispose of small electrical products containing lithium batteries

リチウム内蔵の小型家電の出し方

Lithium ion batteries are used as batteries for electric products that are charged. The number of problems with lithium ion batteries burning up when they are used to dispose of garbage has been increasing all over the country. Workers have been injured, and facilities have been damaged, making it impossible to dispose of waste.

When disposing of small electrical products containing lithium-ion batteries, observe the following precautions.

①Do not remove lithium ion batteries from electrical products and put them directly into a "special collection box" at a local civic center such as a "Shimin Center".

Minimum wage in Mie prefecture is ¥1,023/hour from October 1, 2024. It will be 50 yen higher than last year.

This minimum wage applies to everyone working in Mie Prefecture (Excluding those working in an industry with a designated minimum wage).

Traffic accidents are likely to occur at dusk. Especially from October, when it gets dark earlier, traffic accidents are more likely to occur because the time when people go home after work or school is coincides with dusk.

[Light on campaign period]] From October 1st to December 31st.

Cars, motorcycles, and bicycles: Turn on your lights before it gets dark or when the weather is bad. Use your high-beam lights when there is no oncoming traffic or cars nearby. Reduce your speed and watch out for sudden jumps.

When walking or riding a bicycle Wear reflectors or bright-colored clothes or light reflecting belts outside in the evening. Use LED lights. Turn on your bicycle light before it gets dark.
